



Driving directions to the Spoorwegmuseum Utrecht

From Amsterdam, Rotterdam, The Hague

Stay in the right-hand lane on the A12 motorway > Ring Utrecht, Nieuwegein > Hoograven exit (exit 18) > (underneath the A12 motorway) Hoograven – Lunetten > Exit: Stadion, Centrum > for further directions, see box Route 1.

From Breda and Den Bosch

A27 motorway Utrecht-Amersfoort-Almere > Ring Utrecht-Zuid > Ring Utrecht, Nieuwegein > Hoograven exit (Exit 18) > Hoograven-Lunetten > Exit: Stadion, Centrum > for further directions, see box Route 1.

From Arnhem

Stay in the right-hand lane on the A12 motorway > Utrecht-Nieuwegein-Breda (A27) > Ring Utrecht-Zuid > Ring Utrecht-Nieuwegein > Hoograven exit (exit 18) > Hoograven-Lunetten > Exit: Stadion, Centrum > for further directions, see box Route 1.

From Amersfoort

Follow the A28 motorway to Utrecht until you reach the traffic lights > turn right at the traffic lights > turn left at the roundabout in the direction of Wilhelminapark > at the next roundabout, take the second exit to the right towards Wilhelminapark (from here, you can follow the Spoorwegmuseum signs) > for further directions, see box Route 2.

From Hilversum

Keep following the A27 motorway up to > Exit: Veemarkt-Centrum-De Bilt > (Exit 30) take a right: Veemarkt-Centrum > take a left on the roundabout: Wilhelminapark > at the next roundabout, take the second exit to the right: Wilhelminapark > for further directions, see box Route 2.

Route 1

In front of the stadium, turn left; at the traffic lights, turn left under the motorway; drive straight on – this is Rubenslaan (follow the Museumkwartier signs). At the end, take a right onto Tolsteegsingel. Then turn into the fourth street on your right (one of the prior three streets being a level crossing), Johan van Oldenbarneveltlaan: you have arrived at the Spoorwegmuseum.

Route 2

Turn left at the first traffic lights; you are now on Museumlaan; cross the level crossing; follow the roundabout $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way round and turn into Maliebaan (middle lane); at the end of Maliebaan (opposite the small bridge on your right), turn left into Johan van Oldenbarneveldstraat: you have arrived at the Dutch Spoorwegmuseum.

Opening hours

Open from Tuesday to Sunday from 10 am - 5 pm.

Open on Mondays during school holidays.

Closed on 1 January and Queen's Day (30 April).
