



## Directions public transport

### Can I get to the Spoorwegmuseum by train?

Yes, you can! Every Saturday and Sunday there is a special daily shuttle service train between Utrecht Central Station and the Spoorwegmuseum. Train tickets are available from all NS (Dutch Railway) ticket machines, NS ticket service desks and the Spoorwegmuseum. On the NS ticket machine, you will find the Spoorwegmuseum train ticket under the 'actie' button.

Return fare Utrecht CS – Spoorwegmuseum

Adults €2

Children (aged 4 – 11) €1

Children under the age of 4 travel by train for free

Every Weekend and also from Monday to Friday during school holidays

### Train schedule Spoorwegmuseum – Utrecht CS

Train leaves from platform 1

10.02 am, 11.02 am, 12.02 pm, 13.02 pm, 14.02 pm, 15.02 pm, 16.02 pm and 17.08 pm.

Travel time: 25 minutes

In these special trains, your ticket is valid in first and second class.

### By bus

You can also reach the museum by taking GVVU bus 3 from Utrecht Central Station towards Fockema Andreaelaan and getting off at Maliebaan bus stop.

### Opening hours

Open from Tuesday to Sunday from 10 am - 5 pm.

Open on Mondays during school holidays.

Closed on 1 January and Queen's Day (30 April).
